


### **Installing Cage End Panels**

#### {Before Installation}

• Remove grease, grit, and grime from the side of all End Cages (right) using the alcohol wipes we provided.

**IMPORTANT:** The cages on either end of the assembly must be thoroughly clean and dry for our two-way adhesive tape to hold. See Fig. 1.






#### {Cage End Panel Installation}


#### Step 1

Loosen all External Screws connecting outside End Cage Hinges, Latches, and Trim Plates so End Panels can be inserted behind them. See Fig. 2.



#### Step 2


Peel the white protective covering off of the Cage End Panels. Begin with the Cage on the end of the Bottom Row and locate the appropriate-sized End Panel. Panels vary in height but have slots cut into their front frames to align with Hinge and Latch Screws. See Fig. 3.





#### Step 3

Remove the adhesive tape backing from the End Panel's back lip. See Fig. 4.



#### Step 4


Position End Panel onto Cage so Panel's slotted front frame fits beneath the Cage's Hinge and/or Latch Screws and the two corner Trim Plate Screws. Fit the End Panel directly over the outer-side of the Cage. See Fig. 5.

#### Step 5

Press all four sides of the panel firmly against the Cage side so the two become connected. Provide pressure for about 60 seconds. Repeat for all End Panels.

#### Step 6

When all are installed, tighten all screws (refer to Step 1) on your kennel system securely.



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
